***Travel Ball* is an ensemble sports drama about a father and daughter struggling to hold on. It's about intense competition driving a wedge between best friends, and a coach who lives through his players to rewind his past. They're all on a collision course with hope, money, and the love of a simple game.**

Treatment

James "Grit" Douglas, a former minor league player turned travel baseball coach, is devoted to his players, his soccer star daughter Avalon, and his wife Bianca, who's stood by him since their love story began in Venezuela. But Grit soon learns that loyalty doesn't always go both ways when his star pitcher, Skylar, leaves for an elite travel team offering national exposure and swag.

Grit, though a grounded coach, struggles as an overbearing soccer dad. Avalon cringes at his sideline outbursts and takes an unexpected leap, accepting a Premier League tryout in England without telling him. In this high-stakes competition, she discovers her own strengths and the freedom of playing outside her father's shadow.

Bianca, the glue of the family, is caught between secrets. She's hiding Avalon's journey from Grit and concealing Grit's desperate move, using Avalon's college fund to take his new protégé, Tre, to the Dominican Republic for rigorous baseball training.

As the story races toward a dramatic finish, tensions boil over at a national baseball tournament and everything starts to unravel for Grit, including a heartfelt showdown with Avalon.

In this unforgiving world of talent scouts, pro dreams, and strained loyalties, Grit must answer the ultimate question: Can he hold his family and team together while chasing a victory that could cost him everything?

Tre Jackson, initially seduced by the swag, learns quickly that it’s not about the shoes. His life changes after being betrayed by his former teammate, flame throwing pitcher Skylar Sinclair.

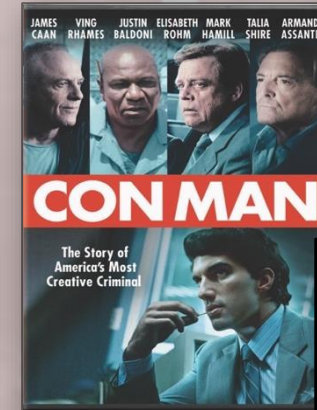
Director's Team

WRITER/DIRECTOR: Bruce McAlester is an EMMY Award winning director and wrote the original screenplay, *Travel Ball*. His recent film, *Con Man* told the redemption gone wrong story of Barry Minkow, the youngest person to defraud Wall Street. The Golden Globe winning, and Oscar nominated cast includes James Caan, Ving Rhames, Mark Hamill, Elisabeth Rohm, Talia Shire, Armand Assante and Justin Baldoni. The film was released by Sony Pictures. A University of Southern California Cinema/Television graduate, Bruce studied Shakespeare at the Royal Academy of Dramatic Arts, London and improvisational theater in Los Angeles with Julliard professor, Steven Book. Bruce has been a DGA member since 2004.

Travel Ball is a family/sports drama that taps into a global audience. It deals with very real family struggles shown in films like *The Blind Side*, while also finding the deeply personal former athlete-turned coach archetype portrayed in films like Disney's, *The Rookie*. The tried-and-true underdog theme, as in *Jerry Maguire* & *Rocky*, is present as is the obsessive human drive behind the plot of *Money Ball*. The depth of the father/daughter, coach/player, and player/player ensemble has you rooting for these flawed yet redeemable characters throughout their journeys from the fields of the Dominican Republic, to the pitches of Manchester England.

Travel Ball Partners is creating a digital platform, “A-Game”, that will help student athletes manage and maintain an optimal mental state for today’s competitive sports environment.

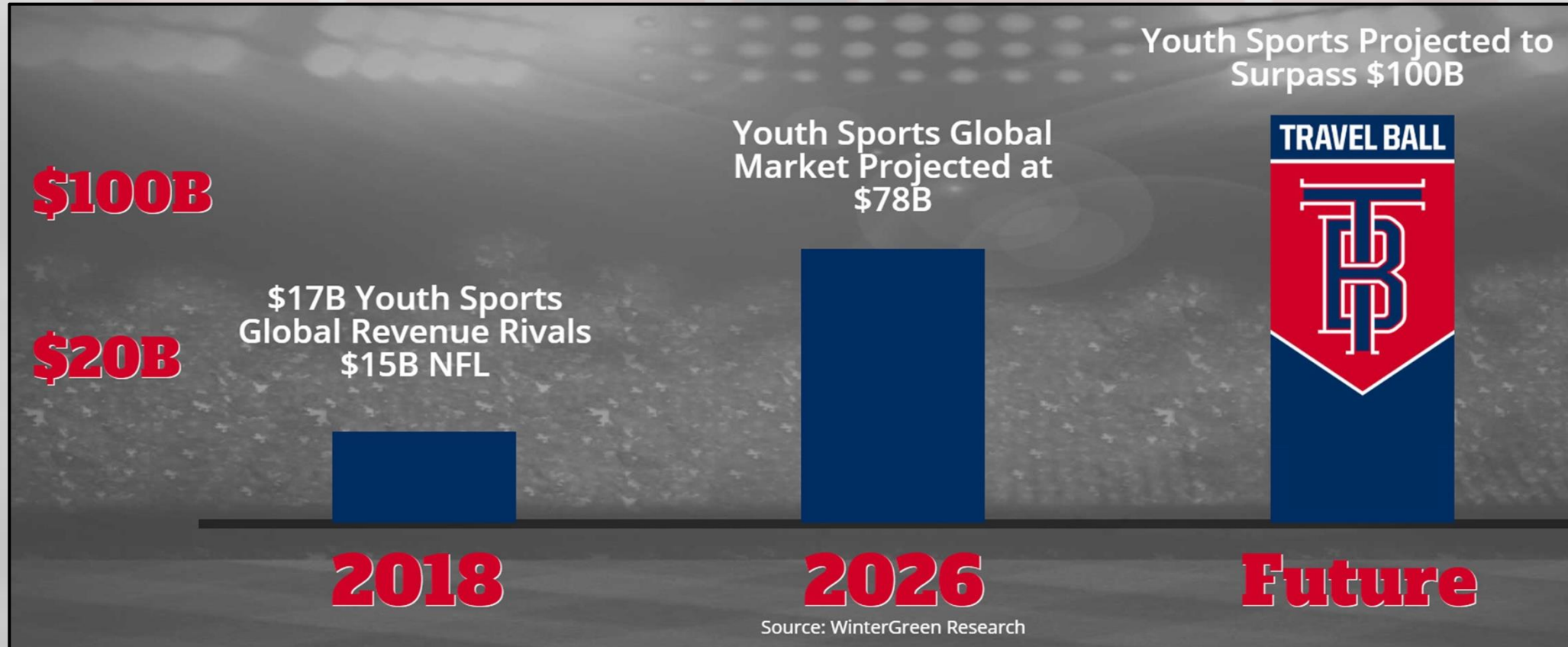
